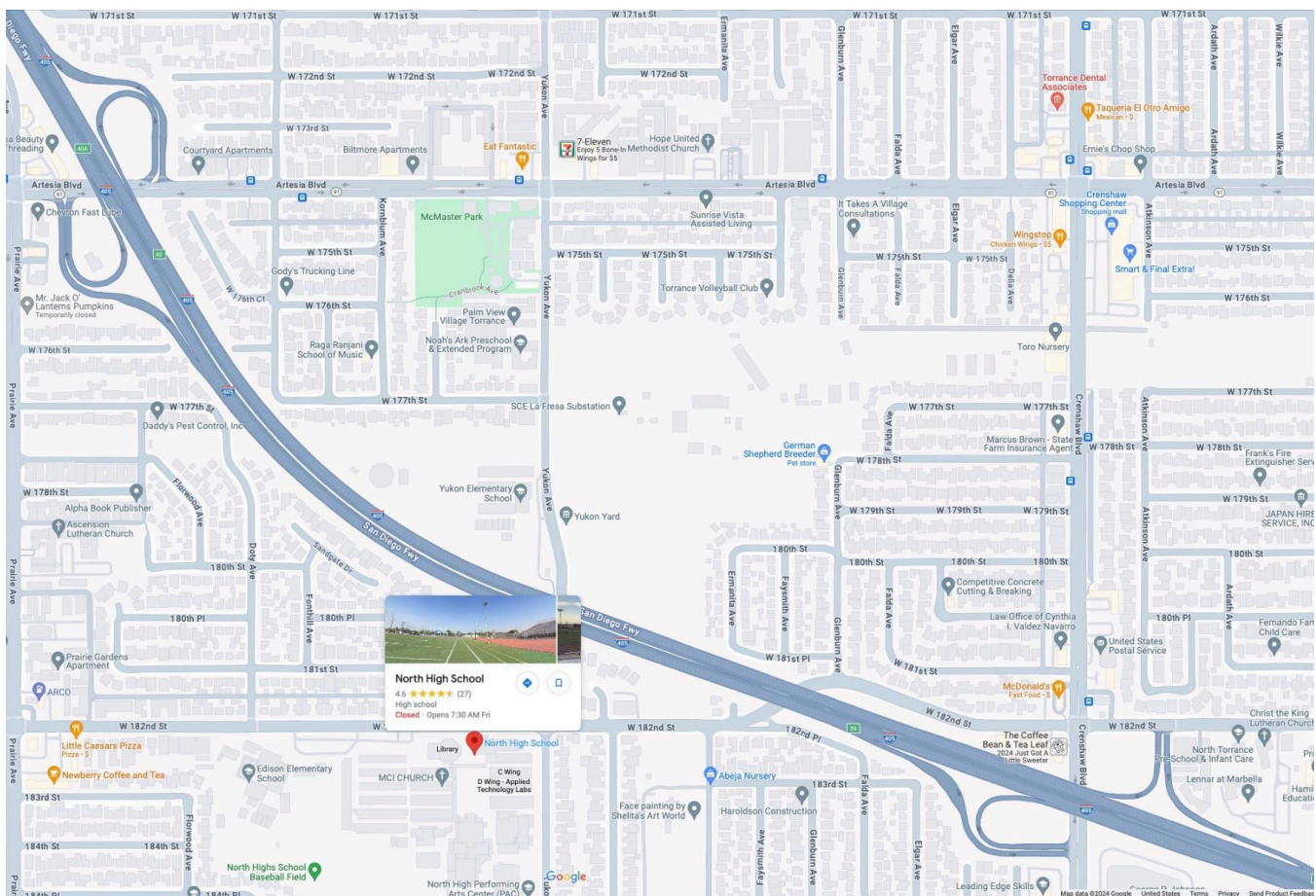
North High School is located off the I-405 (San Diego Freeway) on 3620 W 182nd St, Torrance, CA 90504.
