This event has FOUR trials - two obedience trials, two rally trials. The "first entry" fee applies to each trial. Since rally is a separate trial, a rally entry is not considered an additional obedience entry.

TRANSFERS will be allowed at this trial. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Mats cannot be left on the ground overnight. DAY PARKING ONLY AT THE TRIAL SITE.

1. Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or its event secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its event secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring.

3. Declination of Entries. The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
4. A Recording Fee of 50¢ for each first entry, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the AKC. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
5. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved, provided the next level class (i.e. novice to open) and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
6. REFUNDS
 - Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry.
 - If, because of riots, civil disturbances, pandemic or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
 - No refunds will be given for \$10 or less.
 - BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED TO COMPETE in obedience/rally trials. A refund of entry fees for bitches entered in obedience/rally who come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Superintendent. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening date of the show or given to the Show Superintendent ½ hour before the start of the show. The full amount, less a \$4 processing fee per entry, will be refunded.
7. Exhibitor confirmations and judging programs will be emailed to the electronic address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the secretary.
8. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the Agreement of the American Kennel Club, which follows the entry blank on this premium. Rule books are available at the Secretary's table at the show or may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606.
9. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7am-close of trial each day.
10. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging the breed. Notify the secretary of any discrepancy. No trophies or prizes will be mailed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

11. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
12. All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or exercising ring or confined in crates.
13. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
14. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Valley Hills Obedience Club, Inc, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
15. No smoking near rings and other exhibitors.
16. No ineligible dog will be allowed on the trial grounds.
17. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
