NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Our new location is on property of the Panama Buena-Vista Union School District. Please respect this property and help us retain this site! Absolutely no smoking or alcohol is allowed anywhere on school property (includes the parking lot). **PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!**
- No items can be left on the grounds overnight, no exceptions.
- AKC fees of 50¢ recording, \$3.00 event services, \$3.50 Rally first entry, \$3.00 2nd entry will be required at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules, Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2). Fees must accompany entries. BOTC assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information. Please print or type all entry information.
- Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- Exhibitors' identification tickets will be mailed one week prior to the day of the trial. Exhibitors not receiving them should notify the trial secretary at once.
- BOTC may cancel the events due to extreme weather conditions.
- Dogs need only be present at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for dogs holding up a class. Dogs will be judged in catalog order. Any deviation from this rule requires prior clearance from the judge.
- BOTC will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited whether the result of accident or other

causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care and custody of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial grounds.

- No dogs will be allowed in the trial area except those entered in the trial.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Any exhibitor who enters a bitch in this trial who comes in season so as to be disqualified on the trial date, shall have returned, upon presentation to the trial chairman on the day of the trial, a verification of said season signed by a veterinarian, the entry fee minus a processing fee of \$5 per class.
- There will be no admission fee for spectators.
- A free catalog will be available for each exhibitor.
- No Flexi Leads within 50 feet of Rings, Hospitality Table, or Scoring Table during Trial Hours.
- No setups, crates, chairs or other items on any sidewalks or in the aisles between rings.
- This is a **SELF-CLEANING** trial. Please clean up after your dogs.
- All Obedience and Rally classes with jumps will run from Small to Tall.
- A **TRANSFER** to the next level class is permitted, in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a Transfer must be made in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfer forms for Obedience and Rally will be available at the Secretary's Table.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
